“WHERE THE ECONOMY IS GOING”, A PREVIEW OF THE FESTIVAL

The Economics Festival - an event which in the first four days of June 2006 will bring economists, but also internationally renowned philosophers and experts to Trento to discuss and exchange opinions on “Wealth and poverty” - will offer the host city a preview. The appointment has been fixed for Thursday 9 February 2006, at noon, at Palazzo Geremia in Via Belenzani, when the organisers will give a general outline of the first festival and will exchange opinions at a debate with the title “Where the economy is going”. The meeting will be attended by Lorenzo Dellai, President of the Autonomous Province of Trento; Gianluca Salvatori, provincial councillor for planning, research and innovation; Alberto Pacher, Mayor of Trento; Innocenzo Cipolletta, Chancellor of the University of Trento and editor of the “Sole 24 ore” newspaper; Carlo Borzaga, Head of the Faculty of Economics at the University of Trento; Tito Boeri, lecturer at the Bocconi University in Milan and responsible for the scientific content of the Festival in Trento and Giuseppe Laterza, publisher.
